Red Flags

- Is the PTA board described as an unapproachable clique?
- Are the same individuals serving on the board? (flip-flopping positions instead of moving on)
- Is the unit not welcoming new parents or encouraging new families to join?
- Is the PTA visible and interacting with families at events?
- Is the PTA experiencing conflict issues within their group (disagreements, bad mouthing, etc)?
- Is the school administration receiving complaints about the PTA (lack of transparency, personality issues, etc)?
- Are posts on social media being done (by a PTA board member) shedding inappropriate light on the PTA, School or fellow board members?
- Are the Treasurer's books not being provided when requested?
- Does the PTA have an unapproved annual budget they are working off of?
- Are the PTAs fundraisers benefitting just one grade or person? Are they just fundraising constantly with no clear "reason"?
- Is the PTA providing programs to offset every fundraiser (3:1 rule)?
- Does your PTA board meet regularly? Are you invited to sit on the board?
